 - Refugees (fear of persecution)
 - _____ (cultural benefits, opportunities for low countries)

IMMIGRATION POLICY – DACA

- DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals)
 - Renewable two-year period to defer _____
 - Requirements = pre-16 entering, high school or GED, clean record
 - No _____ to citizenship
- Outcome
 - 750,000 applications approved (June, 2016)
 - Increase labor force participation (75,000)
 - States = _____ individual benefits policies

 - Requirements = relatives, job, refugee
 - Priority = date, _____, country of origin
 - Limited number of visas available
- Citizenship
 - 18 years or older
 - Lawfully admitted _____ resident
 - Resident for 5 years
 - Continuous permanent residency
 - Good moral _____
 - US Constitution principles
