## **POPULATION STATISTICS**

## ➢ 42.2 million immigrants

- o \_\_\_\_\_ of United States population
- o India, China, Mexico, Canada, Philippines (most common origins)
- o California, Texas, New York, Florida, New Jersey (most common states living)
- o \_\_\_\_\_ Mexican / Latino
- > 11 million \_\_\_\_\_\_ immigrants
- > 11 million lawful residents or temporary visa

## **IMMIGRATION POLICY - INA**

- > INA (The Immigration Naturalization Act)
  - 675,000 immigrants yearly
  - o Additional temporary basis
  - Additional \_\_\_\_\_
  - Limits per country
- Purpose
  - Reunite families (spouse, minor children, parents of citizens)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ (temporary jobs, special skills, religious workers)
  - Refugees (fear of persecution)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ (cultural benefits, opportunities for low countries)

### **IMMIGRATION POLICY – DREAM**

- > DREAM (Development, Relief, and Education for Alien Minors)
  - Goal = residency for \_\_\_\_\_ immigrants
  - Requirements = high school diploma, good character, no crime
  - Never adopted; 20 states with own \_\_\_\_\_
- > Pros
  - Decrease deportation spending
  - Increase job \_\_\_\_\_\_
  - o Increase \_\_\_\_\_
- > Cons
  - Shield gang members
  - Encourage illegal immigrants
  - o \_\_\_\_\_ migration
  - Public funding

### **IMMIGRATION POLICY – DACA**

- > DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals)
  - Renewable two-year period to defer \_\_\_\_\_
  - Requirements = pre-16 entering, high school or GED, clean record
  - No \_\_\_\_\_ to citizenship
- ➢ Outcome
  - 750,000 applications approved (June, 2016)
  - Increase labor force participation (75,000)
  - States = \_\_\_\_\_ individual benefits policies

### **IMMIGRATION PROCESS**

- Green Card
  - Requirements = relatives, job, refugee
  - Priority = date, \_\_\_\_\_, country of origin
  - o Limited number of visas available
- ➢ Citizenship
  - 18 years or older
  - Lawfully admitted \_\_\_\_\_\_ resident
  - Resident for 5 years
  - Continuous permanent residency
  - Good moral \_\_\_\_\_
  - US Constitution principles
  - o \_\_\_\_\_ English
  - US history / government
