WRITING WORKSHOP #1

Directions: Once you complete your final personal narrative, go through each of the following questions to ensure that your personal narrative is ready for submission!

QUESTION #1 Is my paper written from the FIRST PERSON point of view?

QUESTION #2 Is my paper written in the PRESENT TENSE?

- Your paper should have no verbs written the past tense!
- Watch out for the “-ed”!

QUESTION #3 Do I refer to the setting throughout the ENTIRE scene?

- You should have a snapshot of the setting in almost EVERY paragraph.
- You should be able to run an ongoing video of your scene!

QUESTION #4 Do I switch paragraphs EVERY TIME I switch speakers?

QUESTION #5 Are all of my dialogue lines punctuated correctly?

ADDITIONAL IDEAS:

- Do I place my speaker tags in a variety of places (beginning, middle, end)?
- Could I utilize any additional senses within my scene to make it more descriptive?
- Could I add any figurative language to my scene to add creative descriptions? (Consider onomatopoeia for specific sounds, similes for comparisons, allusions for references, etc.).

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
